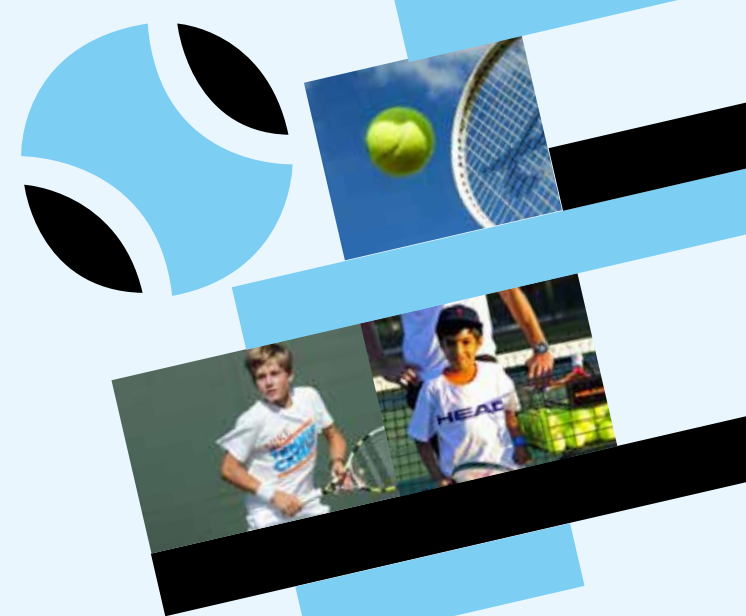
There are a number of novelty events, such as handicap doubles, as a variation to the normal social tennis sessions. These will be advertised on club notice boards and the website.

Held March/April each year after the completion of summer pennant season, to decide the Club Champions in various events. All members are encouraged to participate. There will be events to cater for different standards. The Club Championships is a regular highlight in the club calendar.

TENNIS WEST AND NDTA ALLOCATED EVENTS

Due to our affiliation, all club members are eligible to enter into Tennis West and Northern Districts Tennis Association Tournaments, subject to the tournament conditions. Entrants may be graded into divisions and consolation or plate events are often played for first round losers. Sorrento TC is allocated a number of these and on those weekends social players still have the use of limited courts. Contingents of club members sometimes attend country tournaments.

* #Concessional fees apply for old age pensioners and full time students over 18 - please present your concession card at the office

* Court hire for members only is free during the day but charges apply when lights are used- at half the standard fees (check court availability; provide own balls)

* Reduced charges apply for members hiring courts for play with non-members

COURT HIRE / TYPES OF PLAY

VISITORS

All visitors are welcome to play in our organised social play, subject to standards.

FEES

Fees and times for social play are as per the adjacent schedule and court hire fees apply for all non-organised play.

SOCIAL

The sets are organised to make play as even as possible but there will be times when this is not feasible.

If you wish to have a more serious session of tennis, we have both Tennis West and NDTA pennants seasons available; or organise your own partner for the practice sessions set down.

JUNIOR SOCIAL

Organised play is available on Saturday mornings.

An adult will supervise practice sessions each weekday afternoon from 4.00-5.30pm and will ensure that the club is open.

PENNANTS

We are affiliated with both Tennis West (TW) and Northern Districts Tennis Association (NDTA) which allows all club members to play in any fixtures sanctioned by these Associations.

There are summer and winter competitions which will be advised by newsletter, the notice board and/or announcements at social play when nominations are required.

There is a season's nomination fee and/or playing fee for competition.

Tennis West pennants are available for male or female competition. They are played mainly on grass in summer and hard courts in winter, throughout the metropolitan area. Days of play are Saturday or Sunday afternoons, Sunday mornings for juniors; ladies pennants on Wednesday mornings or Thursday nights; or as is announced from time to time.

DRESS / BEHAVIOUR CODES

- All members are expected to wear recognised and acceptable tennis attire for social and pennant play (NO board shorts, stubbies, singlets, etc).
- Footwear must not mark the courts (NO ripple or track shoes - tennis shoes only).
- Members who do not adhere to the acceptable dress standards and code behaviour can be suspended from participating in social and pennant play.
- All players must practice good sportsmanship at all times.

GRADING

When a player is admitted to the Club, their standard of play will be assessed and a club grading allocated. These grades are updated periodically.

Tennis West player grades are updated through the Tennis West system based on match results, in accordance with Tennis Australia standards.

NDTA pennants are played on Saturday afternoons - mixed teams; male teams on Wednesday nights; ladies midweek pennants on Wednesday mornings.
